

SATURDAY AFTERNOON COMPETITION TENNIS GUIDELINES

(Updated 15/02/2022)

Mixed Pairs Competition

- 1 man and 1 woman play as a team on the day (you may have more team members, and you may use reserve players, if you wish).
- Play starts at 1.00pm and finishes at approx. 2.30pm (complete the game in progress at 2.30pm).
- A match consists of 2 tie-break sets (tie-break at 5-all), with an additional match tie-break (first to 10 points with a 2-point lead) if the match stands at 1-set all.

Competition points: 6 per match (2 points for each set, additional 2 points for the match winner).

The draw and point scores for these competitions can be accessed from the Association's web site: www.ndta.com.au. Click on COMPETITION, then DRAWS & SCORES.

Men's Pairs Competition and Women's Pairs Competition

- 2 men / 2 women play as a team on the day (you may have more team members, and you may use reserve players, if you wish).
- Play starts at 3.00pm and finishes at approx. 4.30pm (complete the game in progress at 4.30pm).
- A match consists of 2 tie-break sets (tie-break at 5-all), with an additional match tie-break (first to 10 points with a 2-point lead) if the match stands at 1-set all.

Competition points: 6 per match (2 points for each set, additional 2 points for the match winner).

The draw and point scores for these competitions can be accessed from the Association's web site: www.ndta.com.au. Click on COMPETITION, then DRAWS & SCORES.

Modified Men's & Ladies Doubles Competition

When there is a shortage of teams to complete a full competition draw or schedule (minimum 4 teams) teams will be made as follows:

- The 4 male or female players from Mixed pairs will form a team.

For example:

Brian /Barbara	v	Brett /Jill
Chris /Leila	v	Neil /Debbie
Men's Example Draw		
Brian /Brett	v	Chris /Neil



Male or Female teams will rotate depending on mixed pairs draw each week.
A list of reserve players will be made available.

Points will be awarded as follows:

- Winning team will receive 1 point each
- Losing team will receive 0 points

- The Men's or Ladies draw will be emailed to participants & printed copies will be made available in the Pro Shop.
- Results from modified competition will be uploaded to a PDF file for viewing on our website weekly by the following EOB Wednesday.

Playoffs

In the modified draw there will be no playoffs. Results will be based on First past the post.

Eligibility for Semi-Finals/Finals/Playoffs

- A player must have played in two matches for a pair in the preliminary rounds to qualify for semi-finals, finals, and positional playoffs.

** However, one (1) player who has only played one (1) match may be used in semi-finals, finals, and positional playoffs, if necessary, provided that this player is not a member of any other pair in that competition.

Cost

- \$10 associate membership fee to be paid each financial year (Due 1st of July each year)
- \$15.00 per player per afternoon, if playing in 2 competitions
- \$10.00 per player per afternoon, if playing in 1 competition

Prizes

Prizes for winners and runners up in each competition will be monetary credits placed on players' accounts at the Association shop.

Afternoon Tea

Afternoon tea is provided by the players. If you wish to partake in afternoon tea, please bring a small plate to share.
